The program is vertically aligned to the Master in Maritime Administration program being offered by the AIMS-Graduate School with various specializations.

The doctorate program specifically covers four areas of specializations. These are: Maritime Education, and Training Management (MET); Shipping Management (SM); Logistics and Supply Chain Management or (LSCM); and Ship Safety and Security Management (SSSM).
